Special Needs Trust Network Hosts Multi-State Regional Planning Conference for the Launch of the National Pooled Trust Alliance

Denver, Colo. – On July 15th and 16th The Special Needs Trust Network (SNTN) hosted the first multi-state regional planning meeting to launch the National Pooled Trust Alliance at the Loews Denver in Cherry Creek.

Representatives of pooled trusts from Colorado, Arizona, Kansas and Wyoming convened for two days to discuss the formation of a national pooled trust administrators' alliance. The purpose of the proposed alliance is to provide a forum for pooled trust administrators to build connections and discuss topics of common concern. The Alliance will also seek a national voice on issues related to disabilities.

Discussions centered on the creation of the National Pooled Trust Alliance, housing equality and regulatory issues for people with disabilities and operational challenges to pooled trusts. "We are tremendously honored to host this conference and for the first time bring together so many experienced leaders in the world of pooled trusts. Working together only enables us to help people with disabilities to have a stronger financial future and voice" said Rita Blackwood Executive Director of The Special Needs Trust Network.

The findings of the conference will be presented in a national forum at the Stetson Conference in Florida in October 2011. A further regional conference is scheduled for July 2012.
